St Cecilia Autumn Term Curriculum Letter

This term, we will be learning about 'It's all Greek to me?'. This letter will give you some key information about what we will be learning this term and how you can support this learning at home. Please see below -

Subject	Content	Supporting your child home
Religious Education	We will study 3 topics: Ourselves- Created in the image and likeness of God. Life choices- We look at marriage, commitment, and service. Hope- advent; waiting in joyful hope for Jesus; the promised one.	Read through verses related to our themes at home form your bible. Make a collage using family photographs of all the significant family members—grandparents, parents, children, aunts, uncles etc. who show God's love. Write underneath it "We show God's love to one another." Include those who have died. Talk to someone who has been to a Baptism and/or Confirmation about their memories of this celebration. Find out about some Christian symbols for Advent e.g. Advent wreath, calendar, Jesse tree. Use the CAFOD or Mission websites to get a religious Advent calendar. Reflect upon what makes your children special. Discuss respect and how to show this.
English	Book studies: Stormbreaker by Alex Rider, Pig Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman. Your child will have the opportunity to develop their writing skills through writing a narrative, a biography and a non-chronological report, whilst also developing their GPS skills within their writing	Complete your homework weekly. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/subjects/zv48q6f Read regularly with your child.
Maths	In Maths we will continue to follow our Power Maths White Rose Scheme. We will be focusing first on improving children's place value skills and then using these to develop their knowledge of addition and subtraction and then multiplication and division. We will then move on to fractions.	Practice times tables daily.
