To help our children take a pride in belonging to Holy Cross School, we encourage all of them to wear school uniform. A uniform fosters a pride in the school and a sense of belonging. This in turn helps to develop a greater awareness of personal appearance and self-respect which is reflected in sound attitudes, both social and academic.

All uniform must be clearly labelled.

Winter uniform is worn from after October break until Easter, and summer uniform only will be worn from Easter until October break.

GIRLS (Years 1 – 6)

Summer: royal blue and white gingham dress with royal blue cardigan with school logo, or grey skirt with short sleeved light blue blouse royal blue cardigan with school logo, white socks/tights, **black or dark sensible shoes** (but not trainers).

Winter: grey skirt, pinafore or trousers, light blue blouse school tie, royal blue cardigan with school logo, outdoor jacket, grey socks/tights, **black or dark sensible shoes** (but not trainers or boots).

Physical Education: navy blue or black shorts, white collarless T-shirt, black plimsolls or trainers for outdoor games, one-piece swimsuit (for key stage 2 please), navy blue or black tracksuit for the colder weather.

BOYS (Years 1 – 6)

Summer: long or short grey trousers, light blue shirt, royal blue school jumper with school logo, outdoor jacket, black/grey socks, **black or dark sensible shoes** (but not trainers).

Winter: long grey trousers, light blue shirt, school tie, royal blue jumper with school logo, outdoor jacket, black/grey socks, **black or dark sensible shoes** (but not trainers).

Physical Education: navy blue or black shorts, white collarless T-shirt, black plimsolls or trainers for outdoor games, swimming shorts (for key stage 2 please) navy blue or black tracksuit for the colder weather.

All uniform, other than school jumpers, cardigans and ties can be purchased at low cost from most high street and supermarket stores.

It is vital that all children wear proper uniform at all times. Children must be in summer uniform until October half term. Children also need a coat-preferably with a hood in the inclement weather.

Nursery and Reception:

Light blue school plain / logo T shirt, school logo blue sweatshirt and navy blue or black jogging bottoms or jersey shorts with black trainers with velcro.

Hair:

Hair which is longer than chin length (boys or girls) must be tied back for 'health and safety' reasons. Hair 'ties' and beads should be in school colours— blue or gold—or black or white. Hair should be worn tidily; no extreme hairstyles or ornaments.

Hair extensions must be in the natural hair colour. Pupils should not wear hair gel or wax or dye their hair.

Jewellery and Accessories:

Jewellery must not be worn except small gold or silver studs for those with pierced ears, only one pair in the conventional place. **Friendship/charity bands, 'Saints' bracelets are all included in the jewellery ban and must not be worn to school.** Wrist watches may be worn at parent's risk (not smart watches).

All jewellery, including stud earrings, must be removed for Physical Education sessions. Make up and nail varnish must not be worn.

When children do not wear the full school uniform, they will receive a letter from their class teacher as a reminder in the first instance and this will be followed up by a phone call from the Headteacher if this continues. Please let us know if you require financial assistance to support you in buying school uniform as we may be able to support you in accessing funding and support for the purchasing of uniform.
