Subject – PE

Intent -

At Holy Cross Catholic Primary School, physical education is an important part of our curriculum that is inclusive and engages all pupils. Children develop the knowledge, skills and competence to excel in a broad range of sports and physical activities. We aim to deliver high-quality teaching and learning opportunities that enables all children to achieve their personal best through the use of the Get Set scheme which provides teachers with clear curriculum skills and knowledge progression. Children participate in competitive sport, ensuring they do their best and that they display good sportsmanship. We aim for all children to be physically active for sustained periods of time and to make informed decisions to lead healthy and active lives.

Implementation -

Children participate in high-quality PE lessons twice a week covering two different sports/skills per term. Teachers use the yearly curriculum map and the progression skills map to plan PE lessons effectively. Teachers follow the curriculum map to ensure the children are participating in a variety of sports throughout the year. Children compete in the Thurrock SSP partnership competitions and local football matches against other schools and take part in the Borough Sports (KS1 And KS2). Children attend swimming lessons in key stage 2. We provide children with a wide range of opportunities to participate in extra-curricular activities that are inclusive, enjoyable and increase children's physical activity.
