Dear Parents/Carers

EYFS Educational Trip to Barleylands – 17th April 2024

We are hoping to take our Nursery and Reception children to Barleylands for an educational visit on **Wednesday 17th April**, due to the children's interest in animals. The children will get to hear the story of 'Little Red Hen', make bread and have a tractor ride.

We will be leaving school at 9.30am on the coach and return to school by 3.00pm in time for the end of the school day; we will have our lunch at Barleylands. If you wish, you can provide your child with a packed lunch which should be contained within a disposable plastic bag. The lunch should contain a sandwich or wrap, a piece of fruit and a small treat such as a biscuit or yoghurt – if you are providing yoghurts, please include a disposable spoon. You should also supply your child with a bottle of water. Sweets, fizzy drinks and glass bottles are strictly prohibited. If you would like the school to provide your child with a packed lunch at the usual cost of £2.40 for Nursery children and free for Reception children, please tick the relevant box on the attached permission sheet.

The cost of this visit will be £24 which includes entrance to Barleylands and coach fare. This payment can be paid in 2 instalments of £12 each and should be made via Arbor. Unfortunately, we are no longer able to take card payments at the School Office. If you are experiencing financial difficulties at this time, you are welcome to make an appointment via the School Office to discuss further. Please be aware, however, that this trip will have to be cancelled if not enough parents are willing to pay this voluntary contribution. **We would be grateful if permission slips are returned and first instalment paid by Friday, 1st March, with the second instalment due by Friday, 22nd March latest.**

We will also need parent volunteers to accompany us on this trip. There will be no expense to you as a volunteer apart from bringing your own lunch. If you would like to be a volunteer, please let your child's class teacher know as soon as possible, as the trip will also have to be cancelled if we don't have enough parent volunteers. Should we have more helpers than needed, we will pull names out of a hat.
