## **Spring Term Curriculum Letter**

This term, our topic will be 'We are Britain'. This letter will give you some key information about what we will be learning this term and how you can support this learning at home.

Subject	Content	Supporting your child home
Religious Education	This term we will be discovering Jesus's life from Galilee to Jerusalem and then from Jersulem to the Desert. These two branches of learning are about Jesus' life and ministry. We will be reading Scripture about John the Baptist, some of the miracles of Jesus and the Easter accounts. English	This term we are reading Grandad's Camper, Tadpole's Problem, The Minpins and The Bear Under the Stairs. We will cover writing sequel narratives, own-version narratives, extended explanations and information texts. PSHE	In PSHE we will continue with the Ten:Ten programme. Throughout their sessions the children will be encouraged to notice similarities and celebrate differences between fictional people and each other as things that make us unique and special. They will also be encouraged to notice similarities and celebrate differences between girls and boys on physical, emotional and spiritual levels. Building from these sessions, the children will learn how to take care of their bodies.	•	Talk to your child about how to celebrate similarities and differences between people, including our God-given bodies and the things they enable us to do.
Computing	In Computing this term, we will be focusing on Word processing, Programming using Scratch Jnr. and Online Safety. The children will learn about word processing and develop their touchtyping skills. They will explore what 'blocks' do, using the app 'ScratchJr,' and program a familiar story and an animation of an animal. They will learn about online safety, including what happens to information posted online; how to keep things private online; who we should ask before sharing online; describing different ways to ask for, give, or deny permission online.	•	Discuss with your child how they can stay safe when using devices such as phones, tablets and computing games. If they have access to a laptop or keyboard, encourage your child to practise their touch-typing skills on Word.

**PE Days – Monday** and **Tuesday**. Please remove your child's earrings on PE days. If your child uses their PE kit for an after-school activity, please make sure their kit is returned the following day. Please make sure every item of PE kit is named. The children will need a winter PE kit including a tracksuit.

**Reading** - It is extremely important that your child reads EVERY night. By reading daily, your child will be exposed to a range of authors and genres and this will help them to perform better in their own creative writing tasks. Please can you sign the reading journal each time you listen to your child read with an expectation that your child will be listened to at least 5 times per week. Reading records must be in school every day.

**Homework**: Maths homework will be sent home on a Wednesday and returned by the following Wednesday . English homework will be sent home on a Friday and is to be returned the following Thursday.
